3. All the End-Semester (Even-Semester) Examinations for **LL.M. programme** will be held in the **afternoon between 02.00 p.m. and 04.30 p.m.** at the UG Block as per the above mentioned schedule.
4. Students should produce the Identity Card on demand by the Invigilator / Authorities of the TNNLU during the Examinations.
5. No student shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the expiry of 60 Minutes from the time of commencement of the examination. Students will be permitted to leave the examination hall only on submission of answer book to Invigilator and they will not be permitted to re-enter.
6. Students should write their Register Number, Course of the Examination and Date of the Examination at the appropriate space provided in the main answer book only.
7. Any student who writes his/her Register Number on any part of the answer book/sheets other than in the space provided or makes any special mark or marking which may disclose in any way the identity of the student, will be liable for disciplinary action.
